

Northwest Line JATC is currently seeking experienced qualified Journeyman Linemen for a **Training Coordinator** opening. We are looking for enthusiastic, energetic individuals interested in the training, instruction and certification of apprentices, entry-level vocational line school students, journeyman and other industry classification workers.

This full time position will be located in the Vancouver, WA office, but travel throughout the geographical area of the program is required for both crew visits and instructional training. The ideal candidate will be comfortable working in a variety of situations, both on the job site and at the administrative level, as well as with the Committees and training partners of the NW Line JATC. Candidate selected will be required to live in the Vancouver/Portland Metropolitan area.

The successful candidate will work with the Director and staff in the area of apprentice management to ensure successful completion of on the job training and related instructional training. Participation and/or instruction in the classroom (both with and without the assistance of other Journeyman) and at our Camp Rilea Training facility is required. Candidate will also be teaching related industry courses (First Aid/CPR, Flagging, OSHA-10, CDL, Crane Certification, Rigging & Signperson) as well.

**Candidates not having current trainer status for these courses may still be considered but will be required to get trainer status.*

The successful selected candidate should meet the following basics:

- *Self-starting motivational personality with the ability to bring and maintain a positive attitude.
- *Have a strong desire to teach and mentor students with the ability to make learning fun and interesting.
- *Ability to clearly communicate verbally and written in a professional manner with colleagues, students, and staff
- *Proficient in PC software applications including Windows applications, video files and the ability to learn the apprentice tracking software.
- *Can Modify/Develop training materials
- *Familiar with OSHA regulations
- *Able to perform the physical requirements of the trade, ie. climb poles and towers, operate digger derrick, etc.
- *Able to present new ideas and methods as well as support tried-and-true methods.
- *Prior experience teaching apprentices both on the job and in the classroom is preferred but not required.
- *Take direction and other job assignments as given by the Training Director of the NW Line JATC

Resumes will be screened to determine those best qualified to participate in the interview process, which will take be scheduled the week of **February 26th – 28th**. Resumes accepted after the closing date will be rejected.
