On April 29, 2008, at about 10:30am, an Apprentice Cable Splicer cut his forearm while skinning wire.

The Apprentice was removing insulation from secondary cable and lost control of the knife. The blade cut through his sleeve, and into his arm, resulting in a 5-6 inch laceration.

The Apprentice was given first aid at the scene, and transported to Swedish Medical Center. He was treated and released on light duty the same day.

No investigation will follow. The Apprentice was wearing proper clothing and PPE.
