RAYMOND — Robert "Shorty" Remington, a lifetime South Bend resident, died Tuesday, Jan. 23, 2018, at the Raymond Care Center; he was 95. Robert was born in South Bend, to William and Katherine (O'Shaughnessy) Remington on June 16, 1922.
