\$50,000 REWARD



REWARD

The International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) and IBEW Local 483 are offering a \$50,000 reward for original information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for leaving a hateful and threatening sign at the IBEW Local 483 Union Hall on November 24, 2021.

DETAILS

IBEW Local 483 seeks information regarding a threatening message placed at the Union Hall at 3525 S. Alder St., Tacoma, WA on November 24, 2021. The threat, written on white paper, featured a target and the words: "Do your job Stop the Job Before it becomes open season on Dykes." The person or persons responsible were seen on security footage driving the dark colored vehicle pictured above. IBEW considers this a hate crime.

IBEW will make the decision to issue a reward based primarily upon law enforcement's evaluation of the information provided. A \$50,000 reward will be paid upon the arrest and conviction of the person(s) responsible. If there are multiple claimants, the reward will be shared in amounts to be determined by IBEW. This reward offer expires on May 7, 2022.
